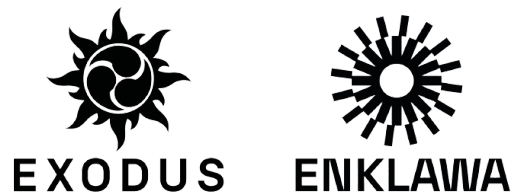


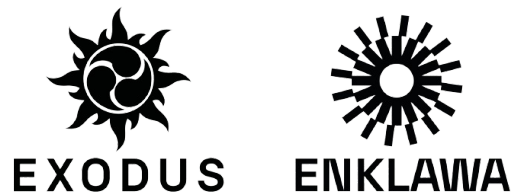
RULES & REGULATIONS

VI Enklawa Winter Camp

1. The event area includes only the premises of the Technical and IT School Complex (Zespół Szkół Techniczno-Informatycznych), Rycerska 2 Street, 82-300 Elbląg.
2. Participation in the 6th Enklawa Winter Camp requires on-site registration at the event venue and presenting an identity document during registration.
3. Minors who wish to participate in the event are required to provide the Organizers with written consent from their parents or legal guardians, using the template attached to these Rules (below).
4. The Organizers, volunteers, and participants are not guardians of children or persons under 18 years of age — full responsibility for persons under 18 rests with their parents or legal guardians.
5. The Participant acknowledges that they attend the event at their own risk and responsibility. The Organizer is not responsible for situations resulting from failure to comply with the above provisions, as well as with regulations and instructions issued by the Organizer.
6. The Participant bears full financial liability for any damage caused by them on the event premises, both to other participants and to the Organizer's property.
7. The Organizer is not responsible for the consequences of force majeure. Force majeure is an event beyond the Organizer's control which makes performance of obligations impossible or may be considered impossible due to the circumstances. Force majeure includes: weather conditions, failures or disruptions of electricity or lighting supply devices, acts of war, actions of state or local authorities.
8. Persons without identifiers and/or identification wristbands are not allowed to stay on the event premises. The Organizers allow checks of identifiers and/or wristbands by security staff or the Organizer.



9. On the event premises, there is a total ban on alcohol consumption and tobacco smoking by minors.
10. On the event premises, there is a total ban on the use of any intoxicating substances.
11. The Organizers of the VI Enklawa Winter Camp are not responsible for health damage, accidents, etc., occurring on the festival grounds or outside of it.
12. Participants are prohibited from entering areas excluded from use by the Organizers (marked with tape or a written notice).
13. Each Participant taking part in general programme activities is responsible for the condition and safe use of their own equipment used during training sessions and shows, in particular equipment for fire performance.
14. Each Participant is prohibited from using asbestos and asbestos-containing materials, both during any shows involving open flame and anywhere on the event premises.
15. The Organizers have the right to exclude from participation any person who, by their behaviour, has significantly violated these Rules.
16. The Organizers have the right to exclude any person about whom complaints are received from other Participants of the 6th Enklawa Winter Camp — this applies in particular to behaviour towards other Participants
17. Any situations involving violation of the law (e.g. theft, robbery) will be immediately reported to the relevant services, and in such a case the Organizers may provide all available evidence.
18. Some Organizer roles will also be performed by volunteers, who will oversee the proper course of the event
19. Resolution of any disputes and decision-making in matters not covered by these Rules, as well as the right to interpret all provisions of these Rules, rests solely with the Organizer.



20. The Organizer records the course of the event for documentation, promotion and advertising purposes. The image of persons staying on the premises may be recorded and then disseminated for documentary, reporting, advertising and promotional purposes.

21. Each Participant declares that they consent to the processing of their personal data and to the use of their image for promotional and marketing purposes.

22. The following are prohibited:

- a) damaging signage and information boards, advertising media, devices and equipment located on the event premises,
- b) any actions, in particular throwing objects that may pose a threat to life, health or safety of persons staying on the premises,
- c) damaging lawns, shrubs and trees located on the event premises and in adjacent areas,
- d) political or ideological agitation.

23. The Organizer reserves the right at any time to measure a Participant's body temperature and, in case of suspected infectious disease, to call medical services and to remove the Participant from the event if recommended by medical services.

24. Participation in the event constitutes acceptance of these Rules by the Participant.

25. These Rules enter into force on the first day of the event and apply throughout the entire event period, i.e. 22–25 January 2026.
